How to register as a K-12 Educator:

- 1. Check your membership first to qualify for the pass your NCA membership must be current through December 1.
- 2. Have a K-12 school as your affiliation in your membership account.
- 3. Answer Yes to "Are you currently an active K-12 educator?" in the Special Registration Rates section.

Special Registration Rates: **K-12 Educators Pass:** Active K-12 educators will receive free registration. Affiliation must reflect a K-12 school to receive this rate and you must be a current NCA member.


How to register as a friend/family member of an attendee:


1. Create a profile. Each registrant must have a profile in our system to register for the convention. While members can create a profile on behalf of a friend/family member, members cannot register them under their own existing NCA membership profile. Our system prevents a single profile from registering for the same event multiple times, so each attendee needs their own profile. If you have already created a profile, please skip to step 2.

To create a profile please do the following:
