

CASC Top Paper and Top Student Paper Awards

This award is to be presented to the author(s) of a submission that is deemed to have made an important contribution to our understanding of Social Construction from a communicative perspective. Selection criteria will include creativity, contribution to knowledge in Communication as Social Construction, and practical applications of the article. Nominees may only be a part of one solo or co-authored submission to the awards committee in this category.

Examples of work that fits within this call include (but are not limited to) explorations of social situations, symbolic interaction, social space, temporality, social rules and norms, social performance, role negotiation, and the presentation of self and the engagement of others in interaction.

The lead author of the nominated work must be a member of the CASC division during the year in which the award is made.

The deadline for submitting work to be considered for the awards (and conference acceptance) is Thu, March 31st, 2022, 11:59 PM (EST). Please make sure to indicate “student work” on your submission if applicable.

Award recipients will be notified prior to the convention via email. Awards will be presented at the CASC Business meeting at the 2022 National Communication Association Convention. **We reserve the right to not give out an award if no nominees are considered to meet the criteria.**
