
#### 1. Must be an e-mail address

#### AND


2. Must be the same e-mail address associated with the account you used to register.

#### To access online sessions:

- 1. Log into to NCA Convention Central
- 2. Click the convention program tab
- 3. Use the "search program" link
- 4. Select "Virtual" as the session sponsor and change the "include" dropdown menu to "sessions only"
