Quick Reference Guide

Two Ways to Present at NCA:

Option 1: Submit through a Unit

Submit these to NCA units directly. Check each [unit's call](#) to see which types they accept.

Individual Submissions (use Individual Form)

Submission Type	Description
Extended Abstract	Incomplete paper; grouped into sessions by planner
Individual Paper	Complete paper; reviewed individually, grouped into sessions
Individual Performance	Single performance; grouped into performance sessions
Individual Film	Single film; grouped into film sessions
Individual Media	Single digital art, podcasts, VR, etc.; grouped into media sessions
Scholar to Scholar	Interactive poster presentation with one-on-one discussions

Session Submissions (use Session Form)

Submission Type	Submission Form
Paper Session	Pre-formed session of multiple papers
Performance Session	Pre-formed session; single or multiple performances (max 1hr 15min)
Film Session	Pre-formed session of film(s) (max 1hr 15min)
Media Session	Pre-formed session of media work(s) (max 1hr 15min)

Panel Discussion (use Panel Discussion form)

Submission Type	Description
Panel Discussion	Pre-formed session; presenters discuss topic (no papers)

Option 2: Submit Directly to a Special Series

Submit directly to these series—NOT through units (unless requested by the [units call](#)). Watch for individual calls for each.

Series Name	Description	Format
G.I.F.T.S.	Teaching activities, assignments, games for classroom use	Round robin (7-min rotations)
Research in Progress	Works in progress receive feedback at roundtables	Roundtables (6 per table)
Pre-conferences	Full/half day sessions on Wednesday before convention	Full or half day (Fee required)
Short Courses	2.5-hour education/training sessions with learning outcomes	2.5 hours (Fee required)
